

MEASURES FOR PREVENTING THE SPREAD OF CORONA VIRUS (COVID-19).

Measure

The municipality has a responsibility to prevent infectious disease, cf. Section 7-1 of the Infection Control Act, and must implement measures cf. Section 4-1 of the Infection Control Act (Smittevernloven), to prevent the transmission of Corona virus (Covid-19).

We refer to the announcement from the municipal crisis management and the doctor in charge in Stranda municipality 12.03 2020.

The measure will apply until further notice and the situation is considered continuous.

«Today, the crisis management and the doctor in charge have stated that no cruise ship passengers will be allowed to go ashore in ports in Stranda municipality. This is to prevent and limit the spread of corona virus (Covid-19).»

Unfortunately, this will also affect **all** passenger traffic in the Stranda Municipality Seafront area (Stranda - Hellesylt - Geiranger - Liabygda):

- Cruise
- Hurtigruten
- Sightseeing Boats
- Charter traffic by boat
- RIB boats

In addition, we have received the following message from “The Fjords” regarding the ferry Hellesylt - Geiranger.

"Due to the ongoing pandemic and bookings cancellation, we have decided today, to postpone the start of the ferry routes on the Geirangerfjord until April 30. We're make ongoing assessments and will come back with an update."
